If you would like to print out the owls, can you cut them out and sequence them by size. If not you can use your toys to sequence them by size from biggest / tallest to smallest/ shortest.	Share a story from your home / read a story from Oxford Owl https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk	Write dance and an activity from your home such as jigsaws/ small world / construction

With an adult, can you practise your knife skills to cut up soft pieces of fruit or vegetables for you and your favourite teddy? Can you feed you teddy some food? How many pieces of food have you fed your teddy?	Break/ snack	Singing nursery rhyme "5 currant buns" and practise counting.	Complete your knowledge organiser poster about a badger.	Share a story from your home / read a story from Oxford Owl https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk	Write dance and an activity from your home such as jigsaws/ small world / construction
