For each key event draw a small picture and write a caption to explain what happened.</p> | <p align="center">RE <u>Easter</u></p> <p>Why do we celebrate Easter? What is the Easter story? https://www.topmarks.co.uk/easter/easterstory.aspx Use the link above to create your own book or comic strip about the Easter Story.</p> | <p align="center">MATHS <u>Shopping Lists</u></p> <p>Take a receipt from your last supermarket shop but take off the total price. Can you add up each item to find the total cost? If you had £200, how much change would you get?</p> | <p align="center">PE <u>Be Active</u></p> <p>Create an exercise routine. Try to remember to include stretches as well as exercises to get your heart beating fast. Can you teach it to someone else in your house? Watch Joe Wicks 5 minute videos on You Tube for ideas.</p> |
| <p align="center">SCIENCE <u>Magnet Hunt</u></p> <p>How many items in your house can you find which have a magnet in them? Look everywhere: wardrobes, kitchens, bathrooms, furniture, toys etc.</p> | <p align="center">WRITING <u>Family Rules</u></p> <p>Write a set of family rules, could they begin with 'We always.....' rather than 'We do not</p> <p>Get everyone in your house to sign the rules to show that you all agree.</p> | <p align="center">ART <u>My Family</u></p> <p>Create a piece of artwork entitled 'Family'. This could be a drawing, a self portrait, a sculpture or collage. Which materials have they chosen to use and why?</p> | <p align="center">PSHE <u>Play A Game</u></p> <p>Play a board game as a family. What makes the board game enjoyable? What would make it better? Can you create your own board game?</p> |
| <p align="center">MATHS <u>Counting on and back</u></p> <p>Practise counting on and back from any number. How far can you count on in 10s? 100s? 1000s? Then can you count backwards? Can you spot any patterns?</p> | <p align="center">SPELLING <u>Super Spelling</u></p> <p>All of the compulsory Y3/4 spellings are inside your reading record. How many of the words can you write in 1 minute. Then try again. Can you beat your score? Can you write a short character description under each picture?</p> | <p align="center">RE/Art <u>Easter Egg Decorating</u></p> <p>Ask an adult at home to help your hard boil an egg. Once it has cooled, decorate the egg to look like your favourite book character. There are lots of ideas on Google if you need some eggspiration!</p> |
| <p align="center">WRITING <u>Keep a Diary</u></p> <p>Keep a diary of how you are feeling each day, what you have done and what is happening in the world around you.</p> | <p align="center">WRITING <u>A Stranger Comes to Redcar</u></p> <p>Write a story about a stranger who arrives in Redcar and the strange and mysterious things which begin to happen after he arrives.</p> | <p align="center">GRAMMAR <u>Adjective A-Z</u></p> <p>Can you think of an adjective for every letter of the alphabet?
