Reading

Writing

Write a list of the different animals you would find on a farm.

Use adjectives to describe the animals, tell me the colour, how big they are etc.

Can you write facts about the animals? You could ask for help to search on the internet for some facts.



Maths

As well as accessing Mathematics, can you work on addition and subtraction? You can do this practically; I find that using food keeps the children engaged. You could add two groups of fruit/crisps/sweets together - record the number sentence. You could then eat some of the food, again record the number sentence.

Creative

Sing 'Old MacDonald had a Farm' together. You could try changing the words to 'Old MacDonald had a Zoo' and add the sounds of other animals.

Make puppets or masks to use when singing the song.
