Reading

Share a book daily with your child. Read aloud and talk about the story. Look at the illustrations and talk about what is happening. You could even act the story out with toys and become the characters. Most of all have fun with it.

Don't forget to keep us all updated via your child's 2Build Profile.

Writing

- Ask your child to write out the tricky words they are working on at the moment on pieces of paper and turn them into a pairs game.
- Ask your child to draw or write a shopping list to help plan for the weekly shop. Encourage them to ask all family members views on what they would like to eat that week.
 - Ask your child to help plan a movie night/ afternoon. Select two films from a streaming service or DVD's you have in the house. Ask them to draw a picture to represent each film or write out the title.



Maths
