Story of the week: The Enormous Turnip




Please continue to read and share stories as much as you can. For this week can you focus on **The Enormous Turnip**.

Retelling/Acting out the story!

By reading/listening to the story each day your child will begin to develop and be able to join in with simple phrases from the story. Can you encourage your child to join in with the parts that repeat? Can you use family members, toys, and pets to act out the story? Why not video it for a minute and upload to your 2Build Profile. Mrs Bell and Mrs Jordan would love to see you all joining in and acting the story out.



Maths Size - Can you go on a hunt around your home finding lots of different objects that are different sizes?

Can you put them in order of size from the tallest to shortest, using language tall, short, big, and little?

The Enormous Turnip - Mini Pocket book.

Can you make your own pocket book? Draw simple pictures of the characters from the story, don't forget to label them. Once you have completed your book you can retell the story to your grown-ups. Can you explore them? What are they called? What do they smell and feel like? Can you do some observational drawings of them?
