
We have now changed over to 'Evidence Me' Please continue to update us via this. You should all have received a link to follow.



Let's do some baking! Baking is fun!

What equipment will you need? First, allow your child to write a list of all the ingredients you will need, and equipment you will need. 2YO can you draw some pictures of a mixing bowl? Spoon? Flour? Tell your grown up what you have drawn. Talk about flour and make some bread rolls together. Make and knead the dough, then shape it into rolls and bake them in the oven! Talk about the changes and what is happening. What does it smell like? Feel like?

Don't worry if you don't have the ingredients to make bread, you can simply just bake cakes or decorate biscuits.



Make a model windmill. You can use cardboard boxes. Talk about the colours and shapes you have used.



Preposition Game.

Can you use an object - this could be a farm animal, baby, car etc. Now ask you child if they can put the object, on top, next to, under, in front of. Here is an example? Can you put the hen on top of the book? Under the book? Next to the book etc. You could read the book '**Rosie's Walk**' this is great for some prepositional language. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=aynZh1-fsBg>
