


Year 3/4 Home Learning Summer 2 Week 2

They each pay for part of the meal. See if recognise any of them.</p> 	<p align="center"><u>DT</u></p> <p>We would like you to make your own map of the seven continents. You can use anything you want and be as creative with your designs too. You can use scrap paper, paints, pasta etc.</p>
