**Writing your own Story!**

Let's write and make up our own story. What do we want to write about? Where will the story take place- this is called the 'setting'? Who will be in your story, a 'Villain' - A character who makes bad choices/evil? A 'hero' - a character who is kind/helpful? The way to start telling a traditional tale or story is by saying 'Once upon a time'.

2YO- Can you draw pictures of the characters you would like to put in your story? Talk to your grown up about what might happen. Grown-ups you can write this down for your child and use it as their bedtime story.

Right now, you know what you want to write/talk about let's get started. We can't wait to hear your story. Grown-ups can you send videos of your child telling their story.




**Research**
