#### Learning Project for this week: Ahoy There Matey

- **Draw and label a lighthouse** using the following vocabulary: gallery, service room, cupola, lamp, control room, living quarters, solar valve. Make sure you draw arrows from your labels to the lighthouse to make your work clear to read by an adult at home.



- **Google search** to look for more information about Grace Darling and create your own fact file.



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- **Think how Grace Darling felt.** How do you think Grace would have felt in the lighthouse on such a stormy night? There were no electric lights-just candles. What did she think when she saw the shipwreck? It was very dangerous in the boat so how did she feel then? She had to keep the boat steady for the survivors to climb in and row back to the lighthouse. Pretend you are Grace and write in a thought bubble. You can draw your own thought bubble or use the template.



- **Make a boat-** Can you create a boat for Grace Darling to sail in? What is the best material to use? Why? Describe the properties of your chosen material. You could use anything you have at home, from recycled bottles to washing up sponges!
