Can you build a castle using different 3D shapes? Can you name and describe the shapes?

Write numbers in a line to 20. Use this number line to practice counting backwards when you take away. Write and complete take away number sentences.

Creative

Construct a castle for the knight you can use Lego, blocks or junk modelling.

Can you use different media and materials to create collages of a Knight or Princess?
