
Please continue to update us on your child's learning via 'Evidence Me'. We really enjoy seeing your pictures.

#### Literacy

Can you draw a story map following where the little boy goes on his journey? Label and name the characters that are included in the story.

Choose a favourite character from the story - can you write a different story about them? Can you write a letter to one of the characters in the story?

Write a list of the characters in the story - do you recognise any and know which other story they are from?



#### Creative

Can you build a house for the three little pigs in the story? Perhaps you could go outside and find twigs to build it out of.

Make masks or puppets of the characters in the story. You could make Humpty Dumpty with an egg to use for the maths job.

Design and make a fairy tale castle using junk modelling.

#### Maths

Who is the tallest in your house? Can you order the people in your house from smallest to tallest/tallest to smallest? Find other objects around your house and put them in size order.

Build different sized walls for Humpty Dumpty. Can you make one as tall as a chair or as small as cup?

#### Physical
